## **GIVING**

We anticipate that financing our ministries in 2024 will cost approximately £535,175, which equates to £44,578 per month. The majority of St Michael's income comes from congregational giving (around 70%).

To fund the church's mission in 2024, we are looking to raise our congregational giving by **3%** compared to the current level of 2024 income.


